
Through daily teleconsultations, we can achieve significant improvement in adherence to the sepsis bundles recommended by the Surviving Sepsis Campaign from the Society of Critical Care Medicine (volume administration in 3 h and lactate measurement in 6 h). According to multicentre observational studies, the mortality rate of patients with severe sepsis and septic shock is reduced from 50% to 33% within a 1.5-year period (same SAPS-II and SOFA scores).

TRANSFER ASSISTANCE

Level 3 Intensive Care Patients. A systematic approach *DAD Consulting Berlin*.



International transfer of acutely ill patients is a complex and time-critical process. It requires excellent communication and coordination between the sending, the receiving and the transferring teams.


DAD Consulting Berlin has introduced a systematic approach for transferring critically ill patients, which provides an operational framework for clinical teams and reduces the potential for both human and system error.

Patient transfer is a major activity in health care with significant resource implications for health systems. Our attention is focused on the emergency transport of acute and critical care patients. However, a large proportion of patient transportations are of a non-urgent nature.

In both emergency and non—emergency transfers, communication failures can result in last-minute cancellation or delays of the transfer, or dangerous transfers. This frequently causes frustration to the patient, their family and delays of further therapeutic or diagnostic procedures.

Delays in the international transfers of critically ill patients are certainly avoidable.

Preparing a patient for international transfer requires time, communication and frequent discussions between doctors. This can be facilitated by *DAD* consultants who take time to understand the patient's needs and requirements and help meet the criteria of the receiving team to ensure successful and timely transfer.



Our expertise in minimizing transport delays and international transport failure includes:

- Assisting to meet receiving teams' policies required for transfer
- Supporting completion of the required medical and transfer documentation
- Ensuring equipment compatibility
- Providing effective communication in German, English and Arabic between medical teams

Knowledge of local policies and regulations

Understanding national and local policies, specific approaches to "health and safety", infection control regulations, and awareness of cultural and religious sensitivities, reduces the preparation time to facilitate patient transfers from one country to another.

Good preparation of the required documents, medical records and meeting safety criteria prior to the arranged transfer results in timely and safe transfers. This is crucial for patient safety, family satisfaction and ensures timely continuation of care by the new home team.

For example: UK hospitals follow very strict infection control pathways - failure to inform and provide the most recent MRSA status very often results in cancellation of an otherwise agreed transfer on the day of the transfer. MRSA positive patients require isolated rooms which cannot be booked in advance.



Preparation of medical records and patient documentation

We assist in preparing transfer and discharge letters, rehabilitation plans, nutrition plans, safeguarding issues etc. to meet the expectations of the receiving team.

In the past, poorly prepared discharge and transfer letters together with auxiliary documentation and imaging on compatible systems to the receiving team have resulted in frustrating delays of surgical procedures that patients should have undergone on arrival.



Equipment compatibility

It is vital - and on occasions overlooked - to ensure full equipment compatibility.

Ignoring small and apparently trivial details can cause significant problems when intensive care patient are transferred, for instance with non-compatible connecting systems, i.e. inner cannulas for tracheostomy.

Communication and coordination

International transfer of complex care patients requires good communication, complete understanding of the patient's needs and professiona assessment of how the handover of care can be done safely.

This is a time-consuming task for doctors in the hospitals involved, and therefore at times is done in a less than well-organized fashion. This car lead to misunderstandings, cancellations or delays of international patient transfers.


They are also sensitive to patients' cultural and religious requirements and restrictions. Our involvement improves patient safety, patient satisfaction, the recovery process and medical outcomes.


